Coronaviruses are spread through close contact in any setting, including at work. Here are some tips to help prevent the spread of germs:

- Wash your hands often with soap and water or alcohol-based hand sanitizer.
- Sneeze and cough into your sleeve.
- If you use a tissue, discard immediately and wash your hands afterward.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose or mouth.
- Avoid contact with people who are sick.
- Stay home if you are sick.
- Avoid high-touch areas, where possible, or ensure you clean your hands after.
- Where possible, wear gloves when interacting with high-touch areas. Do not touch your face with gloved hands. Take care when removing gloves. Ensure you wash your hands after removing them.
- Wash your clothes as soon as you get home.



Please remember that physical distancing (maintaining a distance of at least 2 metres or 6 feet from other people) must be adhered to and work duties should be performed at least 2 metres or 6 feet away from other people, whenever possible. Masks and face coverings are now mandatory for all enclosed indoor public spaces across London and Middlesex County. Further information on the bylaw is available here:
